Fleet Safety Council Confidentiality and Privacy Policy

The Fleet Safety Council (FSC) is committed to safeguarding the personal information entrusted to us by our members. This confidentiality and privacy statement outlines the practices we follow in protecting member personal information.

This privacy statement applies to the Fleet Safety Council, The Fleet Safety Council Chapters and the Fleet Safety Council Conference and to any person providing services on our behalf. What is personal information?

Personal information means information about an identifiable individual. This includes an individual's name, home address and phone number, age, sex, marital or family status, an identifying number, financial information, educational history, etc.

What personal information do we collect?

We collect only the personal information that we need for the purposes of providing support and services to our members, including personal information needed to:

- Managing membership in a regional [FSC chapter](#)
- Registration to the annual [FSC Educational Conference](#) or other FSC managed events
- Sending membership details and information directly to our members

The FSC normally collects information directly from our members.

We inform our members, before or at the time of collecting personal information, of the purposes for which we are collecting the information. The only time we don't provide this notification is when a member volunteers information for an obvious purpose (for example, producing a credit card to pay a membership fee when the information will be used only to process the payment).

How do we safeguard personal information?

We make every reasonable effort to ensure that personal information is accurate and complete. We rely on individuals to notify us if there is a change to their personal information that may affect their relationship with our association. If you are aware of an error in our information about you, please let us know and we will correct it on request wherever possible. In some cases we may ask for a written request for correction.
