This award is offered annually by the Hamilton/Niagara Chapter of the Fleet Safety Council. This award is to recognize a Professional Driver who is a credit to themselves, their employer and the transportation industry.

Nomination Criteria

The nominated individual must meet the following criteria:

- Must have a valid driver's license for the class of vehicle being operated and a clean drivers abstract for the last 2 years
- Their employer must be an active member of the chapter for a minimum of 2 years
- Their employer must be a member in good standing
- Must be free of any non-preventable motor vehicle incidents for the last 2 years
- No Preventable freight damage claims or personal injury to passengers for 12 months
- Verifiable acknowledgements of excellent customer service and relations
- Additional consideration will be given for involvement in community service and or volunteer work, including company safety committees
- Special consideration will be given upon verification of unusual courtesy extended to other road users, high personal integrity, as well as acts of bravery arising out of highway occurrences within the award period (July 1- June 30).

Note: Supporting documents may come from employer, customers, vendors, drivers, colleagues and co-workers.
